As a Procurement Manager your primary role is to lead and execute procurement, subcontracting, logistics, and material management functions in support of both capital construction projects and the day-to-day operations of active facilities.

- Lead procurement activities for both capital construction projects and ongoing plant operations.
- Lead procurement activities for large-scale capital construction projects and complex industrial plant operations, with a focus on high-variability, project-based purchasing.
- Develop and execute sourcing strategies aligned with budget, schedule, and compliance requirements.
- Manage complex, non-routine procurement activities beyond simple order fulfillment, including sourcing custom equipment, interpreting technical drawings, and coordinating with multiple internal stakeholders on evolving project scopes.
- Perform day-to-day procurement agent tasks, including writing purchase requisitions, managing approvals, and issuing purchase orders.
- Coordinate subcontracting efforts, including bid evaluations, scope alignment, contract negotiation, and performance tracking.
- Manage logistical activities such as shipment tracking, customs clearance, and delivery coordination to support project and operational needs.
- Support material management functions, including inventory tracking, spare parts ordering, and evaluating warehousing options.
- Identify, evaluate, and develop relationships with suppliers capable of supporting industrial
 capital projects, particularly those familiar with complex build specs, lead time constraints,
 and quality standards.

- Bachelor's degree in Supply Chain Management, Construction Management, Engineering, Business, or a related field.
- A minimum of 8 years of experience in procurement, subcontracting, logistics, or materials management.
- Experience supporting both capital project execution and procurement functions for operating plants or facilities.
- Demonstrated ability to prepare and manage purchase requisitions, contracts, and related documentation.
- Proven track record of coordinating logistics (shipping, tracking, customs clearance, and deliveries) across multiple sites or projects.
- Experience researching, evaluating, and qualifying suppliers for complex technical equipment or services aligned with capital project needs.
- Experience in inventory control, spare parts ordering, and evaluating storage or warehousing options.
- Strong leadership experience, including mentoring staff and aligning teams with organizational goals.
- Willingness and ability to travel to job sites, supplier locations, and operating facilities as needed. Estimated travel is ~10-15%.
